STATE OF ILLINOIS AGE REQUIREMENTS

- 3 yr old Pre-school: 3rd birthday on or before September 1.
- 4 yr old Pre-School: 4th birthday on or before September 1.
- Kindergarten: 5th birthday on or before September 1.
- Grade 1: 6th birthday on or before September 1.
