SEAS the Challenge-Frequently Asked Questions

How does Trivia Night work?

- Our Trivia Night consists of **8 rounds**, with **10 questions per round**.
- Each round will focus on a different theme or category, ranging from general knowledge, pop culture, history, and more.
- At the end of all rounds, the team with the highest score wins!

1. How much does it cost?

- The charge is \$250 a table, payable ahead of time using the QR code on the flyer or cash or check payable to St. Symphorosa School Board, at the school or parish office
- If you divide the \$250 between each team member, it is \$31.50 per person for a team of 8 people or \$42 per person for a team of 6 people. All proceeds benefit the students of St. Symphorosa School!

2. How many players per team?

• Teams can have **6-8 players**. Larger groups should split into multiple teams.

3. How long does the event last?

• Trivia Night typically lasts 2 to 2.5 hours, including a short break in the middle.

Scoring and Rules

4. How is scoring done?

- Each correct answer earns **1 point**.
- Some rounds may include bonus questions worth additional points.
- There will be a bonus question at the end of the night

5. What happens if teams are tied at the end?

• In the event of a tie, a sudden death tiebreaker question will determine the winner.

6. Can we use our phones?

• No phones, tablets, or smart devices allowed during rounds. Cheating = automatic disqualification.

□ Mulligans Explained

7. What are mulligans, and how do they work?

- A **mulligan** is a "free pass" that allows a team to mark a question correct if they're unsure of the answer.
- Mulligans **cannot** be used on bonus questions or tiebreakers.
- A sheet of 5 mulligan stickers can be purchased for \$10

8. How many mulligans does each team get?

- Each team can purchase 1 sheet that gives 5 mulligans for the night.
- Mulligans can be used at any time, but you cannot use more than 1 per round.

9. How do we use a mulligan?

• If you want to use a mulligan, put the mulligan sticker next to the question on your answer sheet before submission.

□ Breaks and Refreshments

10. Will there be a break?

• Yes, there will be a **10-15 minute break** after Round 4. Use this time to grab a drink, snack, or stretch!

11. Will food and drink be available?

- No, this is a bring your own food and drink event
- Since this is a 21 and over event, alcohol is permitted

□ Prizes and Winning

12. Are there prizes?

- First Place-\$250, a traveling trophy and Bragging rights!
- Second Place-\$10 Gift card for each player
- Team with the best theme as voted by all players-Liquor basket

□ Other Questions

13. Do we have to have a team theme?

• No, a team theme is optional but there will be a prize given for the team who has the best theme as selected by votes from all the players.

14. What if we have a dispute about an answer?

• All answers are final after being reviewed by Fr. Kevin. In case of disputes, Fr. Kevin's decision is **final**.

15. Do we need to buy our table ahead of time?

- Yes purchasing your table to reserve your spot is encouraged, but walk-ins are welcome if space allows. □
- Gather your team and reserve your spot no later than May 1st so we can make sure a table is set for your team

16. What if a team shows up late?

• Latecomers can still join but will **miss out on points** for any rounds already completed.

17. What if I want to play trivia but I don't have a team?

• Call or email us and we will put you on a team

18. Will there be other games or raffles?

- Yes, there will be a few short games you can buy into in between some of the rounds. They will be \$2 each or \$5 for all three. The games are played as individuals and not as teams and have no effect on the trivia scores. These games require no trivia knowledge.
- We will also be selling pull tabs and holding split the pot raffles, so bring your CASH
