Handbook Highlight

When a child contracts a communicable, contagious disease, the Health Department advises treatment by a doctor and requires that the child remain at home during the acute stage of infection. A student who had contracted said disease must bring a note stating that the child's doctor has approved the return to school. After an illness, the student should be fever, rash, vomit, and diarrhea free without medication for 24 hours before returning to class. If a child is absent for 3 or more days, they must have a Dr. note to return.
